**Subject: August 14, 2012 primary election polling results for local Pinellas County related races**

**Date: July 23, 2012**

### **Executive Summary:**

This poll of 6,124 likely voters was conducted between Wednesday, July 18, 2012 and Saturday, July 21, 2012. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of June 2, 2012. The sample of voters that were called included a proportional sample of all registered voters in Pinellas and Pasco counties, and only registered Republicans in Hillsborough county that were within U.S. Congressional district 14 and Florida Senate district 22.

All competitive local public office races involving Pinellas County were included in this poll. Statewide races like U.S. Senate Republican and Democratic primary races were not included. The Democratic primary for U.S. Congress in district 13 was not included because there is only one active candidate.

### **Methodology:**

The poll was conducted by an automated phone call polling system, with each voter being polled only on the races that are within their precinct and political party. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the full voter population for each race. The demographics used were: political party, race, gender and age. Political party was removed as a weighting factor for the single-party races.

In order to qualify respondents as likely voters, the first question asked was whether they were planning to vote in the upcoming August 14<sup>th</sup> primary election. Only those voters that answered yes were polled on the races.

The scientific results shown in the summary below should be within at most a 4% margin of error and a 95% confidence level.
