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Subject: November 6, 2012 General election polling results of likely voters for select races

Date: September 5, 2012

Executive Summary:

This poll of 10,706 likely voters was conducted between Saturday, September 1, 2012 and Monday, September 3, 2012. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of August 9th, 2012. The sample of voters that were called included a proportional sample of all registered voters in the state of Florida.

The races surveyed included select U.S. Congress, Florida State Senate and Florida State House races as well as the Pinellas County Sheriff race.

Methodology:

The poll was conducted by an automated phone call polling system, with each voter being polled only on the races that are within their precinct and political party. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the full voter population for each race. The demographics used were: political party, race, gender and age.

In order to qualify respondents as likely voters, only those voters that had voted in a recent election were called and those voters were asked if they planned on voting in the November 6 general election. Only if they responded "Yes" to that question were they then asked about the races in this poll. Also, voter households that had voters of different political parties were excluded from the survey.

The scientific results shown in the summary below should be within at most a 4-5% margin of error and a 95% confidence level.
