**Subject: May 14, 2013 Special Election Republican Primary for Florida State House District 2 Representative, survey conducted for SaintPetersBlog.com**

**Date: April 6, 2013**

**Executive Summary:**

This poll of Florida State House District 2 likely Republican primary voters was conducted on Saturday, April 6, 2013. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of March 3rd, 2013. The sample of voters that were called included random samples of active Republican voters in state house district 2.

The issues surveyed included the race for state house district 2 and favorability of George Scarborough.

**Methodology:**

The poll was conducted by an automated phone call polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the active Republican primary voter population in district 2. The demographics used were: race and age.

The voters polled were chosen at random within the active Republican primary voter population inside of Florida state house district 2. To be a part of that population, the voter had to have voted in one of the Republican primaries in 2012.

The scientific results shown in the summary below have a sample size of 344 and margin of error of 5.3% at a 95% confidence level.
